Meeting is called to order by Renesha Thomas;

Organizational updates

- ASP – they leave on their San Diego trip Friday and return on Tuesday. They are having a trip meeting on Wednesday, March 12. In San Diego, they will be supporting Morgan Jones in running for office as a National Member-At-Large.
- LSHP – they are having a meeting on Tuesday, March 11. At this meeting, members will be signing up to attend the annual New Orleans meeting.
- PALS – they are having a meeting next Wednesday, March 19 at 12:30pm. They will be helping with Browse on the Bayou tours of the ULM COP from 1-2pm on Saturday, March 15.
- PDC – they are currently having elections of officers. They also participating in a blood drive. Brad spoke about Relay for Life and handed out a flier as they are still seeking donations. Tiffany discussed the idea of a PDC sponsored pizza night. It was then decided that a PSS fundraiser would not be a good idea. Everyone was then reminded that this week is Greek week.

Important dates

- Spring event – the possibility of having a Crawfish boil for our Spring Event was discussed. Everyone agreed that crawfish would be a good idea. Prices were discussed and it stated that PSS would begin selling tickets for around \$15 or \$20 right after students returned from Spring Break. Another meeting we set up for next Monday, March 17, 2008, at 12:00pm in room 110 solely to discuss the Crawfish situation and the Spring Event as well as possible times, such as 5-8pm.

Dr. Lawrence then presented some student feedback. She had two items to discuss.

- Participation in the NABP progression exam. It would be given on the afternoon of Friday, April 18. It is more like the ACT in the aspect that you do not study for it. It covers areas covered on the Naplex. This would be a self-assessment exam, meaning it would not graded for like an exam you have to pass, but rather just for students to see where they stand with regards to the Naplex. It is a written test, taken with a pen and paper. The students would get individual feedback.
 - It was later discussed that April 18 would not be a good date for those taking it. The possibility for alternate dates and times was discussed.
- Assessment committee about the P4 exams. A committee met for four hours to discuss the exams. At this meeting, it was decided that it would be better for P4 students if they no longer had to pass 3 out of the 4 exams, but rather maintained an average of 60% across all four exams. If the students then did not succeed at maintaining a 60%, they would have the option of taking a Pharmacy Prep exam, which would again be optional.

Everyone was then reminded of the three professional developments this week. Gentleman on Wednesday is a Vice-President at GlaxoSmithKline, Inc.
